

NEUTRAMAX

Aids in prevention of acidosis in racing greyhounds



What's In It?

NEUTRAMAX exerts a mild diuretic and neutralising effect on acids which build up in muscles and blood during strenuous exercise, thus delaying acidosis and extending endurance.

What Does It Do?

NEUTRAMAX is an alkaline mixture that neutralises excess lactic acid in blood and muscle. Metabolic acidosis leads to muscle cramping and fatigue, reduces performance, delays recovery, and can cause kidney malfunction in greyhounds.

How Do I Use It?

Give 3mL daily mixed into feed or water when greyhound is in hard work. After racing or hard exercise add 5mL NEUTRAMAX to the first 1 or 2 feed or administer directly into mouth. Make sure adequate cool, clean water is available at all times, as NEUTRAMAX will stimulate thirst to improve rehydration after hard work, travelling and in hot weather. Greyhounds prone to dehydration should also be given daily electrolytes such as SALKA-LITE.

How Is It Packed?

NEUTRAMAX is available in 1 and 5 litre packs.
