Troy ERG Injection

Composition
Adenosine 5'-Monophosphate 200mg/mL

Actions
Coronary vasodilator for horses and dogs.

Indications
Production of coronary vasodilatation in anticipation of severe cardiac over load in athletic animals, or in the treatment of myocardial oxygen deficit. Muscle cramp, 'tying up' prevention.

Contraindications
Intravenous injection, anaphylactic reactions have been reported.

Precautions
If used in performance animals, the regulations of the relevant authorities regarding medication should be observed.

Dosage and Administration
Use the contents of this vial within 90 days of initial broaching. Discard the unused portion.
Intramuscular injection only.
Horses 5mg/kg bodyweight.
Dogs 10mg/kg bodyweight.

Injection 20mL

Storage
Store below 25°C (Air conditioning). Protect from light.
